GETTING STARTED

Chip Distribution: Guests receive their initial chips at their first gaming table.

Starting Amount: We recommend starting with \$200 in chips per guest. This amount can be adjusted to your preference—just let us know so we can prepare the appropriate denominations.

CHIP MANAGEMENT

Chips Stay at the Tables:

- Guests don't carry chips between tables.
- Dealers issue vouchers for the chips guests hold when they leave a table.
- Guests present the voucher at their next table to resume play with their current chip balance.

CHIP DENOMINATIONS & BETTING

Chip Values:

Red: \$5

• Green: \$25

Black: \$100

Optional: Red w/ White Stripe: \$500, Blue w/ White Stripe: \$1,000

Roulette uses unique chips to identify players.

Betting Limits:

- Recommended: Minimum \$5, Maximum \$200
- These limits can be customized to your event.

RUNNING OUT OF CHIPS

If a guest runs out of chips, we suggest giving them an additional allotment (e.g., \$200). The goal is to keep everyone engaged and having fun, even when prizes are involved.

CASHING OUT

At the end of the event:

- Guests exchange chips for two-part raffle tickets (provided at no charge).
- Example: \$50 in chips = 1 raffle ticket. More chips mean more tickets and better odds of winning.

PRIZE DISTRIBUTION OPTIONS

- 1. **Announce Winning Numbers**: Draw raffle tickets and call out winners for each prize.
- 2. **Raffle Baskets (Recommended)**: Display prizes with a basket in front of each one. Guests place one half of their ticket into the basket of the prize they want to win.
